Registration fee

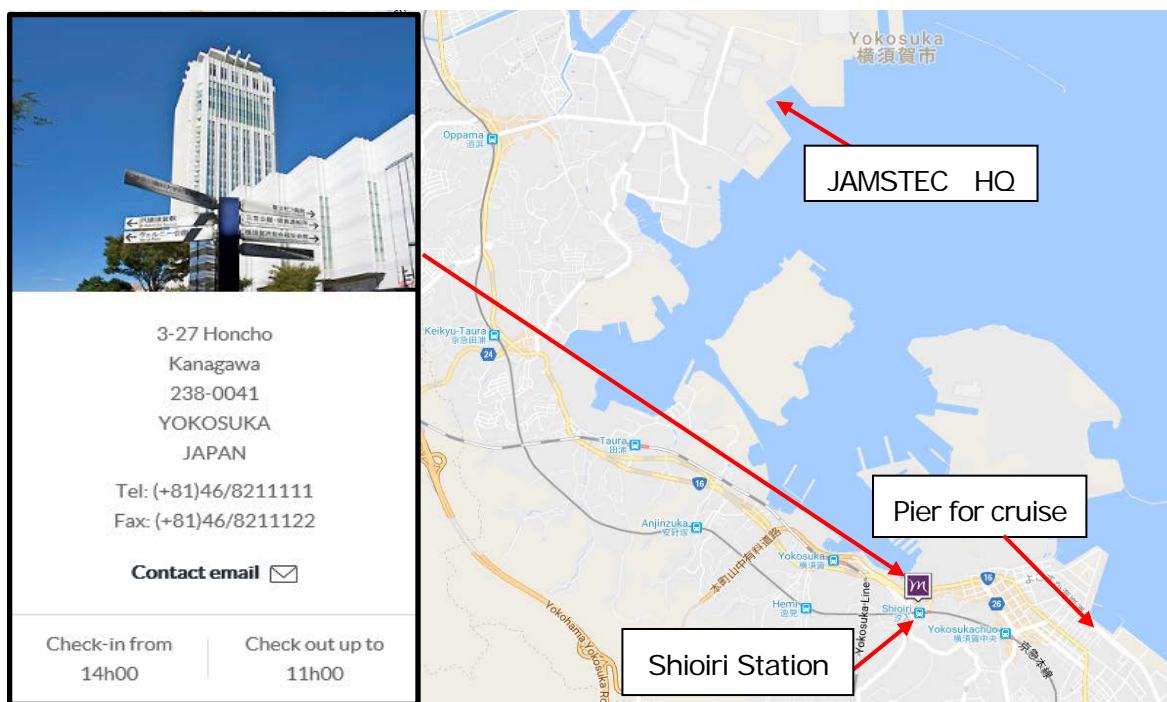

Travel to Yokosuka

There are two international airports to access Yokosuka.

Please check your flight for your arrival airport. (Many air carrier have access to both)

from Narita International Airport to Shioiri Station		from Haneda International Airport to Shioiri Station

Depending on the time and day, you could choose from various route.

For all day, Airport Bus + Keikyu Train is quite comfortable, however you need to travel from YCAT (Yokohama City Air terminal) to Yokohama station for about 5 min on foot.

(In case of using lift/elevator, it may take about 10 minutes.)
