Travel by train:

Yokosuka station -> Kamakura station 30 minutes by JR train (220JPY)

Shioiri station -> Yokohama station 30 minutes by Keikyu train (360JPY)

Shioiri station -> Yoyogi station an hour and 12 minutes (Shinjuku Gyoen)
